

## Information about the processing of personal data for the purposes of the planning and hosting of events and post-event activities (Articles 13 and 14 GDPR)

The following information provides you with an overview of how we handle your personal data (hereinafter, the “data”) and of your data protection rights in connection with events.

## Data processing

### Attendee list

#### *Type and purpose of data processing:*

For the purposes of the planning and hosting of DND events and the post-event activities, we collect your contact details disclosed in your reply card (name, address, e-mail and telephone). The main purpose of this is to ensure the adequate planning of the events (e.g. determining the number of participants, necessary communication, planning of further DND events etc.) and for your identification at a later time. The attendee lists are also used in the hosting of the event so that we can offer you a name badge with your name on it at the time of the event. It is completely up to you whether you accept this offer.

An attendee list is also kept for the purpose of reporting entertainment expenses pursuant to section 4 (5) no. 2 of the Income Tax Act (EStG).

#### *Legal basis:*

The attendee list is kept on the basis of our legitimate interests (Art. 6 (1)(f) GDPR). The data is necessary for the planning and hosting of the event. Your attendance and the use of name badges are voluntary, which is why it is assumed that the data processing is in your interest.

For the specific purpose of reporting entertainment expenses, the relevant legal basis is provided by Art. 6 (1)(c) in conjunction with section 4 (5) no. 2 sentence 2 EStG. It is therefore required by law that the attendee list is kept for this purpose.

*Recipients:*

The recipients of the data are those departments in the company that are involved in the planning and hosting of DND events and post-event activities and service providers who assist in this, if applicable.

*Storage duration:*

The attendee lists will be erased without delay after their purpose has been served.

The name badges will be distributed to the attendees on the evening of the event or disposed of after the event. Digital copies will be erased without delay after the event.

*Mandatory or necessary provision of data:*

Your data is provided voluntarily, because attendance of the event is voluntary. However, the disclosure of data is necessary and required by law for the above-mentioned purposes.

## Photographs

*Type and purpose of data processing:*

During the event, photographs will be taken by a photographer. This serves the purpose of the internal documentation of the event. The photographs will be stored on internal servers and will therefore be accessible exclusively to employees of Dynamit Nobel Defence GmbH. The photographs will not be published!

*Legal basis:*

The legal basis for the taking photographs/making of video recordings and their internal storage for the purposes of the event is provided by our legitimate interest in the internal documentation of the event (Art. 6 (1)(f) GDPR).

It is customary to take photographs/make video recordings at such events.

The photographer is instructed to ensure that attendees who clearly do not want to be photographed are not photographed in a manner that makes them identifiable.

Unless you inform us that you do not want to be photographed/filmed, we will assume that there are no conflicting interests.

*Recipients:*

The recipients of the data are those departments in the company that are involved in the planning and hosting of DND events and post-event activities.

*Storage duration:*

The photographs will be erased without delay after their purpose has been served.

#### *Mandatory or necessary provision of data:*

The provision of personal data is neither mandatory nor necessary to enter into a contract. Not providing the data will have no repercussions for you.

#### Automated decision-making/profiling

In the data processing mentioned here, there is no automated decision-making and no profiling pursuant to Art. 22 (1), (4) GDPR.

#### Your rights as data subject

You may exercise the following rights at any time using the contact details provided by our Data Protection Officer regarding:

- information about your data stored with us and its processing (Article 15 GDPR);
- correction of incorrect personal data (Article 16 GDPR);
- erasure of your data stored by us (Article 17 GDPR);
- restriction of data processing if we are not yet allowed to erase your data due to statutory requirements (Article 18 GDPR);
- data portability if you have consented to data processing or have concluded a contract with us (Article 20 GDPR).

**If you have given us your consent, you may revoke it at any time with effect for the future.**

**You have the right to object, on grounds relating to your particular situation, at any time to processing of personal data concerning you, which is based on Article 6(1)(f) GDPR (data processing based on a balancing of interests).**

#### Change of purpose

Your personal data shall only be processed for purposes other than those described above to the extent permitted by law or if you have consented to the changed purpose of data processing. In the event of further processing for purposes other than those for which the data was originally collected, we shall inform you of such other purposes before further processing takes place and shall provide you with any further information relevant to the further processing.

## Complaints

You may also lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority (Article 77 GDPR).

The right to lodge a complaint is without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy.
